Items accepted for recycling: (Please rinse with water all metal and plastic containers)

- newspapers/newspaper inserts (clean & dry)
- junk mail/envelopes (cellophane windows okay)
- magazines/catalogs/calendars-no spiral binder
- books (hardback & paperback; remove all plastic)
- shredded paper
- telephone books
- paper cartons (egg/berry/fruit; clean; no Styrofoam)
- cardboard (clean, dry and flattened; no pizza boxes)
- bottle plastic #1 & #2(okay to leave lids on)
- tub plastics #1 & #2(yogurt/margarine/coffee; no lids)
- aluminum cans (Please separate for charitable groups)
- tin & steel cans (labels okay)
- pasteboard (Flattened cereal, beverage, pasta boxes, etc.)
- brown paper bags/wrapping paper (no foiled wrap)
- feed or seed bags with rip strings (no feed/seed residue)
- office/school paper (no plastic/metal; office staples okay)
- batteries (rechargeable)
- trash (on a pay per bag basis)
- heavy Metals

We do NOT accept the following:

- glass (Springfield Recycle Centers accept all glass – see [springfieldmo.gov/recycling](http://springfieldmo.gov/recycling) or call 417-864-1904)
- aerosol cans
- aluminum foil
- clear plastic food containers (Springfield recycles)
- Styrofoam in any form (UPS stores accept packing peanuts)
- frozen food microwave dishes (Springfield recycles)
- plastic trash bags/plastic sacks/plastic lined bags (Wal-Mart accepts plastic bags)
- diapers/tissue/toiletries/foil lined paper
- juice boxes/bags/cartons (nothing wax/plastic coated)
- food tainted items (napkins/paper towels/no pizza boxes)
- frozen food/ice cream/milk/soymilk cartons
- pet food bags/original blue prints/thermal fax paper
- plastic toys/furniture
- yard waste
