Progress doesn't always come with a price tag.

Brad Hudson, Stone County Assessor, is pleased to announce an update his office has added to the county's website. Property Record Cards can now be viewed on the web.

"This update comes at no cost to the county and it will make the office function more efficiently," Mr. Hudson said. "Property Record Cards are public information and one is kept for every parcel of real estate in the county. In the past when a taxpayer wanted to view one of these cards they had to either drive to Galena or call the office and have us send them a copy of one. Now someone with internet access can log on to stonecomogis.com and, after choosing a particular parcel, view and print the card that belongs to it."

Mr. Hudson added that not only will this make things more convenient for taxpayers it will also save time in the office.
